- Advertise the Scavenger Hunt a couple of weeks before scheduled event.
- Build excitement with your youth. Let them know that there will be prizes.

Before the game begins...

• Select 2 judges (2 young adults or other adults)

Duties: Keep score of items collected.

Time Keeper: Watch/Record the time of each teams as they finish

- Place youth into teams of 2 or 3.
- Let the teams know that they will have 5 minutes to get as many of the items listed
- At the end of the 5 minutes. There will be a bonus question which will be worth 10 points.
- Remind the them that there will be prizes awarded for the top scoring teams.
- Have 1 pencil and a sheet paper for each person if not sharing screen
- Have each person write down the list of items. Or you can share your screen and they see the list.
- Give list at this time via screen sharing or verbally.
- One point per one item. (NO extra points for duplicates)
- Once everyone has the list ... Time begins. NOW!
- Have a timer to keep time.
- Time is up. Read off the list items. Each team can show you their items.
- Have judges keep score by adding the number of items each team collected
- Prizes may be given out after mass or by doing a Drive-by.

Gospel: Mt. 13:24-30

Jesus proposed another parable to the crowds, saying: "The kingdom of heaven may be likened to a man who sowed good seed in his field. While everyone was asleep his enemy came and sowed weeds all through the wheat, and then went off. When the crop grew and bore fruit, the weeds appeared as well. The slaves of the householder came to him and said, 'Master, did you not sow good seed in your field? Where have the weeds come from?' He answered, 'An enemy has done this.' His slaves said to him, 'Do you want us to go and pull them up?' He replied, 'No, if you pull up the weeds you might uproot the wheat along with them. Let them grow together until harvest; then at harvest time I will say to the harvesters, "First collect the weeds and tie them in bundles for burning; but gather the wheat into my barn.""
